Red Burgundy wines have an elegant personality, fine and structured.

Tasting:

- **To the eye:** purple color with bright reflections.
- **Nose:** The smell opens with a small red fruit basket black (cherry, blackcurrant, blueberry).
- **Palate:** Fresh, structured, fruity with marked tannins without aggressiveness.

Food and wine :

Vegetable salad, cold tabbouleh, meat pies, poultry, red meat grilled, roasted white meat, cooked cheese ...

Service: Uncork one hour before between 16 ° C and 18 ° C

Capacity of aging:

Between 5 and 8 years depending on storage conditions.

Parcel:

- **Variety:** Pinot Noir
- **Vineyard area:** 0.35 Ha
- **Average age of winery:** 14 years

- **Soil:** Silt - Clay
- **Yield:** 53HL / ha
- **Size:** Single Guyot

Winemaking:

- Harvest and manual sorting
- Total destemming
- Fermentation in open vat by indigenous yeasts
- Regular Pigeage

Breeding :

- Aged in oak barrels for 18 months (10% new oak)
- Wine neither fined nor filtered
- Bottling at the Domaine
