This red wine is characterized by a fruity aromatic backed constitution and lends itself to tasty arrangements of simple cooking.

Tasting:

- **To the eye:** ruby with purple and bright reflections.
- **Nose:** Fine fruity notes of red fruit (cherry, raspberry, currant).
- **Palate:** Light, dainty, fresh and fruity.

Food and wine :

Meats, salads, picnics, snacks, barbecues, soft cheeses, camembert ...

Serving temperature: 14-16 ° C

Capacity of aging:

Between 3 and 5 years depending on storage conditions.

Parcel:

- **Variety:** Pinot Noir (40%) Gamay (60%)
- **Vineyard area:** 0.19 Ha
- **Average age of winery:** 55 years
- **Soil:** Silt - Clay
- **Yield:** 40 HL / ha
- **Size:** Single Guyot

Winemaking:

- Harvest and manual sorting
- Total destemming
- Fermentation in open vat by indigenous yeasts
- Regular Pigeage

Breeding :

- Aged in oak barrels for 12 months
- Wine neither fined nor filtered
- Bottling at the Domaine
