Tasting:

- **To the eye :** purple color with bright reflections.
- **Nose:** Rating of red and black fruits and toasted spicy background.
- **Palate:** Ample, structured , spicy, sweetness , roundness and finesse very well balanced. Very nice concentration with great elegance . Very good length .

Food and wine :

Beef steak , foie gras , roasted lamb , forest fowl , cheese intense flavors (Epoisses , Langres , cîteaux ...) chocolates.

Service: Uncork one hour before between 16 ° C and 18 ° C

Capacity of aging :

Between 10 and 20 years depending on storage conditions.

- **Variety:** Pinot Noir
- **Vineyard area:** 0.18 Ha
- **Average age of winery:** 55 years
- **Soil:** Clay - Limestone
- **Yield:** 42 HL / ha
- **Size:** Single Guyot

Winemaking:

- Harvest and manual sorting
- Total destemming
- Fermentation in open vat by indigenous yeasts
- Regular Pigeage

Breeding :

- Aged in oak barrels for 18 months (33% new oak)
- wine neither fined nor filtered
- Bottling at the vineyard

It is located just next to the name " The Echezeaux ".
